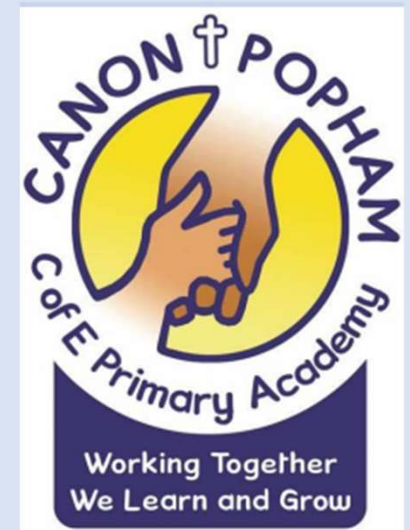

Year 4 Important information

PE is on a Tuesday morning and Friday afternoon. On Tuesday, children are to arrive in school in their PE kits and bring a bag with their school uniform to change into. 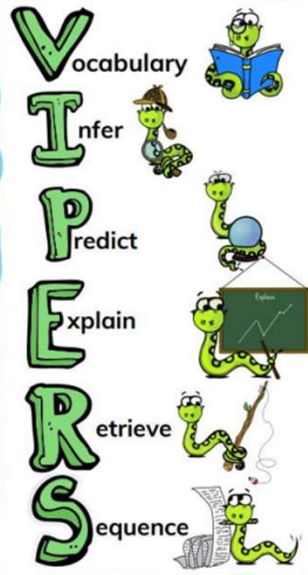
OUR SCHOOL VALUES AND RULES

Ready, Respectful, Safe

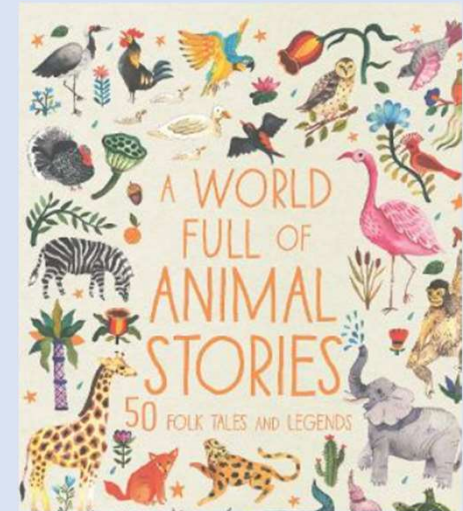

Reading



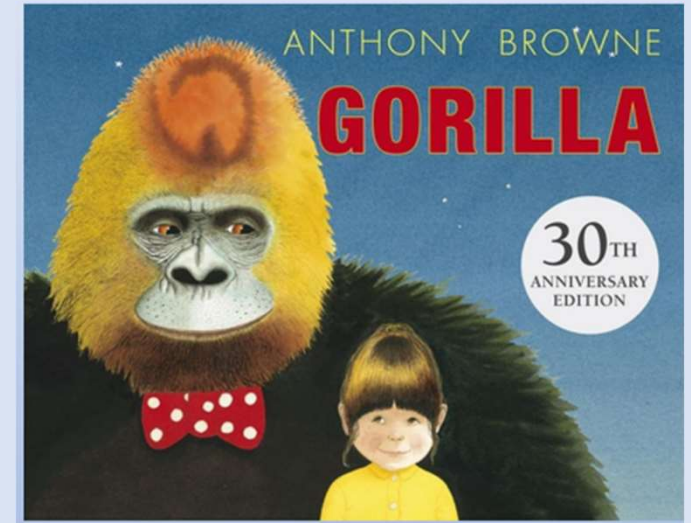

$$400 \times 4 = 1600$$

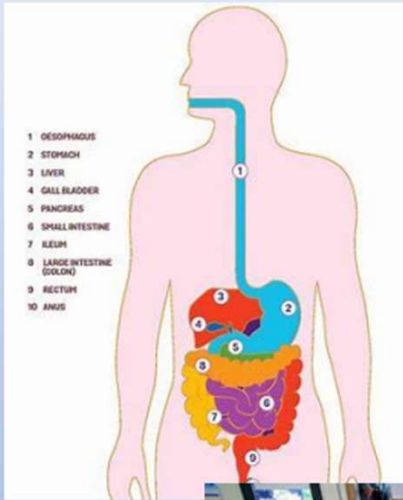
$$30 \times 4 = 120$$
